This car came from Luling, TX, and had been in the garage since 1979 or 1980. It's a 1973 Dodge Dart Swinger. It had 33,4XX original miles on it. Has a 225 slant 6, A/T, factory A/C, and AM radio that still works. It took a lot of cleaning up but it is an all original interior, seats, carpet & panels. The spare tire and jack have never been out of the car. We rebuilt the motor and did a complete rebuild on the brake system. It's now a really nice daily driver.
