HISTORY:

1988 MY WIFE OF 46 YEARS PRESENTED ME WITH THE CAR, (\$300.00).

1988 – 1999 BROUGHT CAR HOME IN A FLAT-BED TRAILER, A PICK UP, AND A SUBURBAN, AFTER SEVERAL HOURS PICKING PARTS FROM AN OVERGROWN FIELD, THE CAR HAD BEEN DIS-ASSEMBLED, ALL BUT CAB WAS ACID DIPPED AND ZINC CHROMATED. SET-UP FRAME AND BEGAN CLEANING AND RE-ASSEMBLING THE FRAME AND SUSPENSION. INSTALLED ENGINE AND DRIVE TRAIN, THEN SET THE CAB. GOT 5 NEW 600/16 WIDE WHITE WALLS FOR CHRISTMAS. INITIAL FITTING OF FENDERS, DOORS, AND HOOD AND TRUNK.

1999-2005 MOVED TO NEW HOME, WITH A 2-CAR GARAGE, FOR RETIREMENT, AND A GOOD HOME FOR THE COUPE. MY SON-IN-LAW, STACY BOND, TOOK ALL BODY PARTS TO HIS GARAGE, THEN THE REST OF THE CAR, AND COMPLETED BODY WORK, AND PAINTED THE COUPE THE ORIGINAL POWDER BLUE COLOR.
